Not only that, as Heather points out, many mass market paperbacks are destroyed when they don't sell at bookstores, but ebooks are never wasted.

As Frances Stockton (www.francesstockton.com/), another Cerridwen Press author, says, being more environmentally friendly just takes some thought. "I try to cut back on how many times I print a manuscript. I like to have a hard copy for my records, then maintain a flashdrive, external hard drive, and work off that rather than print it multiple times. I still love print books, but I hope that ebooks become more and more accepted and that people realize that downloading a book from Cerriden Press or Ellora's Cave can help save a tree. One thing at a time, one step at a time."

Q&A
